- Acceptance to the minor is based upon cumulative graduation/retention GPA of 2.00 for less than 31 hours completed; 2.25 for 31 – 45 hours completed; 2.50 for more than 45 hours completed.
- Minimum of “C” required in all minor courses.
- Minimum of “C” required in prerequisite course ACCT 2103.
- Total hours required: 24
- ADP option must complete 19 credit hours in addition to the requirements for their option.
- Certification of minor upon completion of all coursework and verification of a 2.50 cumulative graduation/retention GPA.

For students seeking a minor in Merchandising who are not majoring in DHM.

Declaring a Minor in Merchandising

1. Visit 431 HSCI to have your cumulative graduation/retention GPA verified and complete the “Undergraduate Academic Program Declaration” form. This form requires your signature and an approval signature of the Department Head.
2. Once you have completed the form and obtained the appropriate signature, bring the form to 101 HSCI.
3. Deliver the form to the Office of the Registrar (324 SU) to be posted to your transcript.

Enrolling in Minor Courses

Certifying the completion of a Minor in Merchandising

1. At the beginning of your final semester or upon completion of minor requirements, file the Human Sciences Minor Certification form in 101 HSCI. Your transcript will be checked to ensure completion of all minor requirements. Once you have been cleared for graduation by the Registrar’s Office, your minor will be certified complete and noted on your transcript.
