Since 1991, Ambassadors has awarded over 300 grants totaling over \$92,000 for county, multi-county and state programming. The grant program was expanded to include Oklahoma Home and Community Education (OHCE) in 1996.

Margaret Edsel Fitch Fellowships established in 1998 and the Blackwell Legacy Award established in 2009 have awarded over \$102,000.

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What are some programs funded by Ambassadors grants?

“Dutch Oven Cooking”

Funding for this grant was used to expand youth Dutch Oven cooking for adults as well by allowing the purchase of equipment and supplies needed to offer hands-on county workshops.

“Active Parenting”

This grant allowed for the purchase of the most recent update of the Active Parenting– the First 5 Years curriculum to be used with clientele in county programming.

“Playaway Audio Books”

This project is used in a junior high school library to promote literacy with the use of more popular and current books that were purchased with grant funds.

“Sensory Stimulation Aprons”

While educating about the benefits of sensory engagement for Alzheimer’s and dementia patients, the recipients of this grant make sensory stimulation aprons to be donated to VA and nursing facilities in their area.

“Comfort Blankets”

The effects of childhood trauma effect a whole community. Even small tokens can provide a source of comfort for children in crisis. Grant recipients make comfort blankets for law enforcement, while learning more about what citizens can do to help protect children in their community.

“Youth and Adult Sewing Workshops”

Grant funding allows for youth and adult sewing workshops to teach beginners how to use a sewing machine, serger and pattern reading, as well as basic alterations for future employment opportunities.

“New Curriculum”

A new curriculum is being developed with grant funding designed to work with food pantries across the state.
